

Eastern Region Solid Waste Management

Community Bin Project GUIDELINES

Program Details: This funding program is sponsored by your municipality and Divert Nova Scotia to assist community groups with the purchase of waste sorting stations to replace single stream containers managed by your group. Access to proper waste sorting stations will assist Nova Scotians to achieve our provincial disposal target of 300kg per person per year.

- 1) Interested community groups must complete and submit the following form by **January 8, 2021**. Please choose the sorting station model(s) that best suits the needs of your organization. Sorting station information can be seen below. Submission of an application confirms interest in this program.
- 2) Submit the completed application for consideration to *Eastern Region Solid Waste Management*. Funding is limited for this program. Applications will be reviewed as received until the fund is exhausted or by the deadline, whichever comes first.
- 3) All applicants will be notified; approved applicants will be invoiced the program purchase price which is approximately 50% of the regular purchase price including shipping. Details will be provided with the notice of approval. *If you qualify*, your notice of approval will include an invoice for the amount owing.
- 4) Payment must be received by Eastern Region Solid Waste Management by the date specified on the invoice or your application for sorting stations will be withdrawn. The approval will not exceed 50% of the total cost of purchase.

There are several different models to choose from, below are the choices available to your organization. The reduced purchase price for the bins below is identified on the application form. If you prefer another bin it will be considered by the ERSWM Committee.

- *Original – 3 & 4 Stream*
- *Mini – 3 & 4 Stream*
- *Community – 3 & 4 Stream*
